UPDATE: Missing Columbia man found safe, unharmed Police searching for 57-year-old man from Columbia

Howard County police are asking for the public's help in locating a 57-year-old Columbia man who hasn't been seen since Nov. 3.

Police have been trying to contact John Warren Hamilton, of Harpers Farm Road, since he was reported missing by a friend Nov. 10. While there are no indications of foul play, police are becoming increasingly concerned as the investigation has turned up no viable leads on Hamilton's whereabouts. They believe he may be in the area of Fells Point in Baltimore.

Checks of cell phone records, area hospitals, friends and relatives have resulted in no information leading to Hamilton. Police are working to determine whether there has been any credit or debit card use on Hamilton's accounts. His car is still parked at his residence.

Hamilton has previously gone missing for days at a time. In June, he was located at an area hospital after being gone for about a week.

It is unknown what Hamilton may be wearing. He is described as a white male, five feet seven inches tall, 190 pounds, with brown hair, hazel eyes, moustache and a heavy build.
