Police investigating single-vehicle collision in Sykesville

Howard County police are investigating a single-vehicle collision that occurred at approximately 4:00 p.m. in Sykesville.

A silver Ford sedan was traveling on Route 32 northbound near the Carroll County line when it left the roadway and struck a pole.

The 36-year-old male driver was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center with serious injuries. The passenger, a six-month-old, was transported to Howard County General Hospital for a check-up.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that the Ford left the roadway, for an unknown reason at this time, and struck a telephone pole. No other vehicles were involved.

One lane of Route 32 northbound and the northbound shoulder are closed while HCPD's Traffic Enforcement Section continues the ongoing investigation.
