### ON TESTING DAY

Applicants are tested first-come, first-served at the times listed above. You do not have to preregister, simply bring a valid photo ID.

Applicants must complete a typing test with a 30 NET words-per-minute score. Passing applicants will be scheduled for a video test on Oct. 10 or 11.

### REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for employment, you must:

- Be 18 years old and a United States citizen
- Have no felony or serious misdemeanor convictions
- Possess a high school diploma or GED
