Cedar Lane sewer extension project to begin

ELLICOTT CITY, MD – A Howard County construction project to extend public sewer to two residences in Columbia is expected to begin on or about Monday, July 30. The project involves the installation of approximately 715 linear feet of eight-inch sewer main, three four-foot diameter manholes and two sewer house connections along southbound Cedar Lane to extend public sewer to 6636 and 6610 Cedar Lane. Weather permitting, the project is expected to be completed by late September.

At a minimum, a northbound and southbound lane of Cedar Lane in the vicinity of the project will remain open during construction hours, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. In addition, during the installation of the sewer house connections, a portion of sidewalk will be closed between 6692 Cedar Lane (Robinson Nature Center) and 6610 Cedar Lane.

Flagging operations will be in place to direct traffic as needed and signs have been posted at the site to advise pedestrians and motorists of the construction and related lane and sidewalk closures.
