Trinity School bioretention facility project to begin

ELLICOTT CITY, MD – A Howard County project to construct a bioretention facility at Trinity School, 4985 Ilchester Road in Ellicott City, is scheduled to begin on or about Monday, July 16.

Howard County's Office of Community Sustainability, in partnership with Trinity School and the Center for Watershed Protection, will install a pond which will provide water quality treatment to stormwater runoff before it flows to an unnamed tributary to the Patapsco River, helping to improve the health of the Chesapeake Bay. Weather permitting, the project is expected to be completed by late September.

While signs will be posted to alert residents of the project, the project is not expected to impact the flow of traffic in the area.

This project is funded through a grant from Maryland Department of Natural Resources Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Trust Fund.
