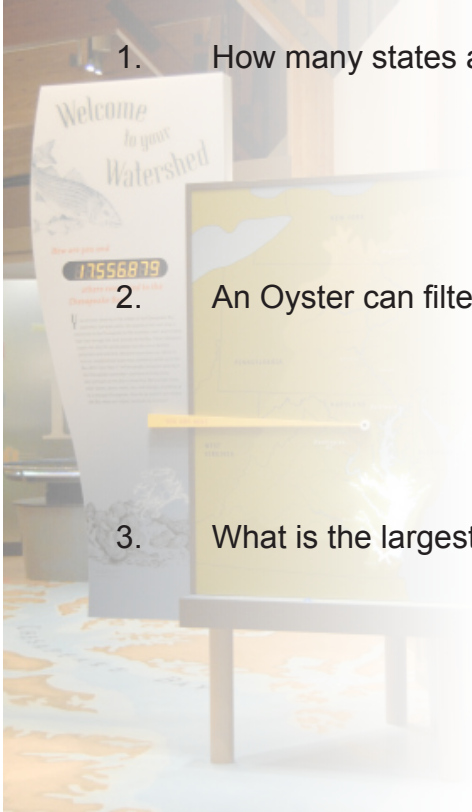


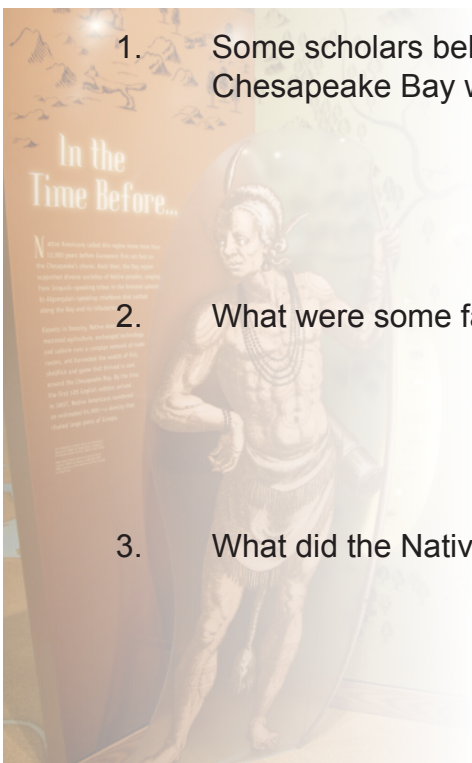

## Chesapeake Bay Watershed Exhibit



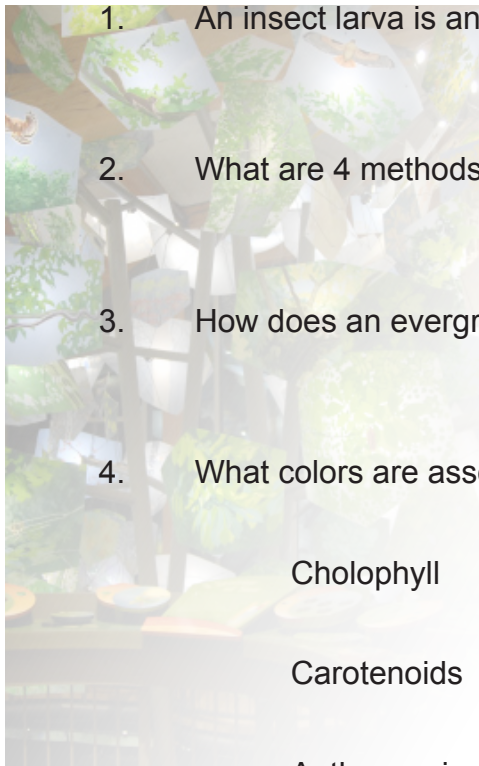
