

Supply List for Oil Painting

To bring to class first time (can be purchased at Utrechts or Plaza Arts or Michaels) Students should feel free to determine the brand based on pricing.

- Oil paints: titanium white, black, alizarin crimson, lemon yellow, cerulean blue – small tubes are fine
- Liquin-oil paint medium (other oil paint mediums are optional)
- Variety of different size oil painting brushes-small, med., large widths-pointed and flat, squared and rounded tips, make sure they're long handled
- Palette-wood or wax paper or flat plastic-don't buy a palette with concave cups-can use aluminum foil wrapped around a cutting board or wax paper clipped to a cutting board or to cardboard as a substitute
- Palette knife for mixing paint-can use plastic knives
- Turpentine or paint thinner-odorless
- Gentle, liquid dishwashing soap
- Container to put turpentine or paint thinner in with lid (glass pickle jar is best) extra cup or bowl to put it in while working
- Container to put palette with paint in (Tupperware) or alum foil to cover palette (to keep paints wet)
- Papertowels/rags
- Box/bag to put it all in!
- Stretched canvas min. size 11x14"
- Ruler or yardstick
- pencil
