Thank you for choosing Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks at Robinson Nature Center for your child's summer camp experience. This letter provides important information about camp, including **required forms your camper must bring with them.**

The camp your child is registered for, **Lil' Acorns High in the Sky Mini-Camp** RP4817.404, is Wednesday through Friday, June 28, 2017 – June 30, 2017. Camp begins at 9:30 AM and ends at 11:30 AM each day. Camp will be held at **Robinson Nature Center** located at 6692 Cedar Lane, Columbia, MD 21044. Daily Routine:

At this camp, we will spend each day learning about nature through crafts, short hikes, nature stories, sensory activities, puppet shows and playing games. There will be time for students to eat a mid-morning snack each day. **Please send a nut free snack and beverage with your child each day.** Registration verification and camper check-in will take place on Wednesday morning as you arrive. Check in begins at 9:15 AM. Each day, guardians are required to sign their campers in and out of camp. On Wednesday, Monica will be your child's teacher. On Thursday and Friday, Tracey will be your child's teacher.

What to Bring:

- The recommended attire for camp is a t-shirt, shorts (or long pants if the weather is cold), socks and close-toed shoes. Please wear clothes that are OK to get a little bit dirty.
- Billed caps and sunscreen are advised. Please apply sunscreen and insect repellent before bringing your child to camp.
- Please pack a small, nut-free snack and beverage each day.
- On the first day of camp, please bring the [Camp Participant Information Form](#) completed and signed for your child. Please note that pick-up/drop-off and medication information in the Participant Information form does not apply to this camp as it is a parent/child camp.
