

## Robinson Nature Center Family Campsite descriptions

To help your family get an idea of what campsites are available for the Lil' Campers Overnight Family Camp experience, please see the photos and descriptions below.

We have two camping areas – one located within our Nature Place play area and the other in the open field between our front gardens and trailhead.

Please note, you will be contacted two weeks prior to the program to select your campsite. Preference is given based on the order in which your family registered.

In the event of inclement weather, we will have our auditorium space available for your family to use. A host campsite where staff will be stationed during the overnight is located directly out front of the Nature Center.

### Nature Place play area campsites



Campsites in the Nature Place are close to the Nature Center for quick access to bathrooms. This site is also closest to the host camp site where staff will be available throughout the camp out. Nature Place campsites are shaded. Ground cover varies between campsites and includes crushed stone, mulch, concrete and decking. See photos and descriptions of sites below.



**Site 1, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is slightly removed from other sites in the Nature Place campsite and is the closest to the host campsite. The site provides a concrete pad for those who desire a flat, untextured camping surface. (Please note, the seating and table will be removed during your stay).



**Site 2, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on the enclosed, composite deck. The site is second closest to the host campsite. Benches can be removed to provide additional space for your family's tent.



**Site 3, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on crushed stone surface on minimally-sloped land and sheltered on one side by the log fence. This site is also very close to the host campsite. This site has access to the Nature Place's underground tube slide (pictured on the left side of the photo).



**Site 4, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on slightly-sloped, mulched surface and is the central site in the Nature Place campsite. This site has access to the rain wheel and musical instruments in the Nature place. During the summer, the site is moderately shaded.



**Site 5, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on slightly-sloped mulched surface and is located on the far side of the Nature Place campsite. During the summer, this site is well-shaded. The site has access to one of the Nature Place's climbing and crawling logs (pictured on the left side of the photo).



**Site 6, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on moderately-sloped, mulched surface and is located on the far side of the Nature Place campsite. The site is enclosed by three of the Nature Place's climbing and crawling logs.



**Site 7, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on minimally-sloped, mulched surface and is located centrally in the Nature Place campsite. During the summer, the site is shaded and is bordered on one side by one of the Nature Place’s climbing logs.



**Site 8, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on a moderately-sloped mulched surface. The site is bordered on one side by the Nature Place’s hopping stumps. This site has access to the Nature Place’s “Mud Kitchen” play area.



**Site 9, Nature Place campsite –**  
This site is located on minimally-sloped mulched surface and is to the left of the Nature Place’s “Mud Kitchen café” area. This site has access to the Nature Place’s “Mud Kitchen” play area.

## Open field campsites



Campsites in the open field are further from the Nature Center. This location is great for families that want to “group camp” with friends. The ground of the open field campsites is covered by grass. See photos and descriptions of sites below.



**Site 10, Open Field campsite –**  
This campsite is the closest of the open field campsites to the nature center. The site is located directly off the paved path on a minimally-sloped, grass surface.



**Site 11, Open Field campsite –**  
This campsite is directly off the paved path on a minimally-sloped, grass surface. Located between sites 10 and 12.



**Site 12, Open Field campsite –**  
This campsite is at the far side of the open field, furthest from the nature center and closest to the trail head. This campsite is directly off the paved path on a minimally-sloped, grass surface.



**Site 13, Open Field campsite –**  
This campsite is nestled against a wooded fragment on a slightly-sloped, grass surface. Located between sites 12 and 14.



**Site 14, Open Field campsite –**  
This campsite is nestled against a wooded fragment on a slightly-sloped, grass surface. Located closer to the Nature center.



**Site 15, Open Field campsite** – this campsite is located closer to the Nature Center on moderately-sloped, grass surface.
