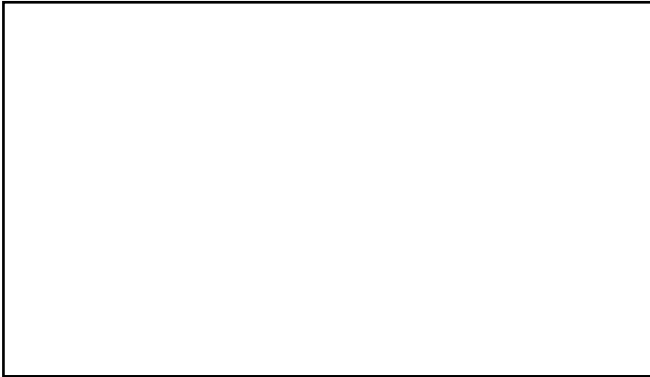

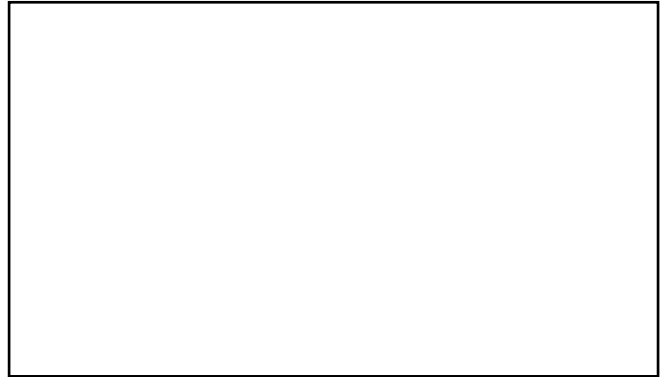
Exhibit Scavenger Hunt

Go downstairs or down the lift to the Forest Floor!

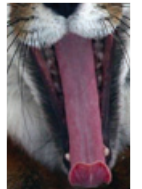
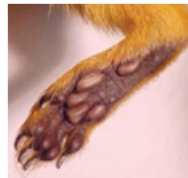
If you were a beaver, where would you live? Circle what your home would look like.
