Policy. County Council unanimously adopted its Complete Streets Policy in October 2019 (CR 120-2019). Since that time, the County has been actively working to implement that policy through the guidance of the Complete Streets Implementation Team (CSIT) and the dedicated efforts of County departments, including the Office of Transportation, the Department of Public Works, the Department of Planning and Zoning, and the Department of Recreation and Parks.

The vision of Complete Streets for Howard County is, as captured in its [policy statement](#):

“To ensure that Howard County is a place for individuals of all backgrounds to live and travel freely, safely, and comfortably, public and private roadways in Howard County shall be safe and convenient for residents of all ages and abilities who travel by foot, bicycle, public transportation or automobile, ensuring sustainable communities Countywide.”
